Chacocente Christian School

Chacocente Christian School (CCS) opened in 2005, offering a tuition-free education to the children of Project Chacocente. Now, 8 years later, CCS offers quality education to over 150 children from the Project and the surrounding neighborhood.

CCS sets itself apart from the Nicaraguan Public Schools by offering a full day of classes, including a nutritious lunch and by smaller teacher-to-student ratios. We also offer classes that are not available in the public school system, such as English, Computer Science and Art. While Nicaragua has the twelfth highest primary school drop out rate in the world, CCS retains nearly 98% of students in First through Sixth Grades.
