WHAT IS THE 13TH MONTH?

Nearly all governments in Central America and many in South America require employers to provide each of their employees with a bonus at the end of the year. Each country's labor department determines the amount. In Nicaragua, that amount is equal to <u>one month's salary</u>; thus each member of our full-time staff receives a "13th month" of salary.

Project Chacocente employs 21 Nicaraguans in full-time positions, and each is entitled to this benefit, which is payable at the beginning of December.
